

NATIONAL TEST SCORES/HIGH SCHOOL PLACEMENT

We are confident our students are prepared for their next level of learning. For example, over 90% of our graduating class of 8th graders test out of Algebra I (traditional 9th grade math) or are placed in Algebra II or Geometry as 9th graders. Each year students in grades 3, 5, and 7 are administered the ITBS/CogAT (a nationally recognized, standardized and norm-referenced test). For 2010, averaging across grades tested in the core subject areas of reading, math, and language arts, *as a school our scores continue to be above average* in terms of national percentiles—74th percentile nationally in language arts (total), 79th percentile nationally in reading (total), 80th percentile nationally in math (total), 82nd percentile nationally in social studies (total) and 88th percentile nationally in science. The following is a chart of our scores from this year. (NPR is National Percentile Rank; GE – Grade Equivalent)
